

PARKMAN TOWNSHIP TRUSTEES
Special Meeting of December 12, 2011

A special meeting of the Parkman Township Trustees was called to order on Monday, December 12, 2011, 7:00 p.m. The purpose of the special meeting was to review applications for the road department. The special meeting had been advertised in The Maple Leaf and The News Herald. Present were Trustees-Kevin O'Reilly, Patrick Joyce, and Nancy Ferguson, Secretary-Renee Patry, Tom Evers, Jon Ferguson, and Paul M. Komandt.

Each Trustee and Road Superintendent, Tom Evers reviewed the 21 applications and had compiled a list of 6 applicants they thought would best fill the open part-time position on the road department. The applicants were then given a point for each time they had been chosen and the first 7 applicants with the most points will be asked to come in for an interview.

It was discussed that in the newspaper ad one of the requirements for the position is a CDL license. One of the applicants has a pending CDL. He was at the meeting and said he was taking his test this coming Friday. Kevin will check with the Geauga County Prosecutor for a legal opinion to make sure they would be able to consider him for the position.


