Happy Fall Parkman. Here's to cooler temperatures, football, sweaters, pumpkins, hot chocolate, falling leaves, and pumpkin spice everything. Since spring the township has been busy trying to make our township inviting to all and to make life better for this community.

The Community House has had a much-needed update. Thanks to the American Rescue Plan Act, we have been able to make some improvements that would not have otherwise been possible within the budget. The interior has been painted. The ballroom floors have been refinished and they sparkle. New curtains have been put up in the ballroom, the dining room, and the meeting room. New comfortable chairs have been purchased for the whole place. We kept 80 wooden folding chairs and 8 eight foot folding tables. These are available for residents to borrow for a \$50 deposit which will be given back upon return of the tables/chairs. Pictures of the new look have been posted on the Facebook page and the website and have resulted in a big increase in rental requests. Please check the Parkman Ohio website for a new schedule of fees for rental.

In an effort to be sure that our structure is fully available to all, we are using American Rescue Funds to build an elevator. The new elevator is in process. The structure has been built and the elevator lift is expected to be delivered and installed in mid to late November. This lift is intended for the use of those who are physically challenged with wheel chairs, walkers or difficulty with stairs. One passenger may accompany those persons. Unfortunately, the cost of a full-size passenger elevator was quite a bit outside our budget. For those who plan to rent the Community House, we ask that you be sure your guests respect those parameters for use.

The Overlook Park has a new shelter for horses. It was built by volunteers from our Amish Community. The costs were covered by the ARP funds. There is a new swing set. Plans are in the works to upgrade the siding on the main pavilion. We approved the plans from a member of the Boy Scouts to build a Gaga Ball Pit for his Eagle Scout project. It seems to be the newest rage among young people to play this game. It is sort of a tamed down version of dodge ball. It will be in the back of the park behind the tennis court. Instructions for play will be posted and a ball for play will be available when the park is rented.

The Overlook Cemetery brick arches are in need of repair and we are working on getting those rebuilt. In order to afford the increasing burial and maintenance costs, it has been necessary to increase the costs of graves and burials. Please check the website for the updated list.

The ODOT salt dome has been vacated. Neighbors whose wells have been contaminated have been identified. When the drilling is done there should be about 20 new wells in that area, paid for by the EPA and the State. ODOT has offered the property to the township for free. We are investigating taking ownership as a possible Road Department facility.

Residents in the sewer district have received a small reduction in their tax rate from the Auditor's office due to the continuously rising sewer costs on a system that doesn't function properly.

The Road Department has worked hard this summer to keep the dirt roads in the best condition possible. We know that those of you who live on and travel down these roads have many challenges. The original chip/seal road plan from 2021 met with various roadblocks, including bad weather, inability to get materials within the window of opportunity, and escalating costs. It has been difficult to get this project out of the starting blocks. With the addition of \$100,000 from the ARP fund to the road budget, four roads were planned and bid this year. The contract was awarded. But, for many different reasons there were delays all summer. Ultimately, we were hit with enormous cost increases and had to postpone work on one of the roads. The roads being completed as we write this are Swine Creek, Nash and Patch. Dead End Shedd had to be put off until next year. We are as disappointed as you. Please bear in mind that chip/sealed dirt roads require maintenance and upkeep in the first year to take care of inevitable potholes. It is a process.

The Gazebo downtown has been repainted and it looks beautiful. We will soon be installing the original Parkman School Bell, donated by the Historical Society, on a structure in the center of the Gazebo. It is part of our focus on maintaining our history and is an exciting project.

Because we are not able to staff the Fire Department at levels we believe to be enough to ensure the best coverage for our residents needing ambulances or fire responses, we are in negotiations with Troy Fire Department. We hope to be able to contract their services to cover Parkman. When these talks and plans are completed, we will hold a joint public meeting with Troy township. There will be a presentation of the plan. At that time, you will be able to ask questions and give your input. The meeting will be announced in the newspaper, on the digital sign and on Facebook and the webpage.

In the meantime, please feel free to contact the trustees by email. Addresses can be found on the website, ParkmanOhio.com. There is also lots of information there about the township, including names and contact information of township officials and employees.

Parkman is working on improving our methods of communicating with you. Search for Parkman Township on Facebook. Like and Follow us so that you can get notifications of messages and posts as well as interesting things to know. There you will find any news that is of immediate importance. Also, the digital sign in front of the Community House has current information on meetings and other important news.

The township has a road levy renewal on the November 7, 2023 ballot. This is not a new tax. This tax began in 1989. It is a small amount of money, but vital to our budget.
